



## Las Vegas team wins Open Championship at WTT Rec League event

### Teams from California, New Mexico, Nevada, Texas and Puerto Rico win titles at WTT Rec League National Qualifier in Las Vegas, advance to National Finals

LAS VEGAS, Nev. (April 23, 2008) – The Las Vegas Longshots of Las Vegas, Nev., captured the World TeamTennis Rec League Open Division Championship over the weekend at the Darling Tennis Center in Las Vegas. The Open Division Championship was part of the WTT Rec League National Qualifier.

Rob Kinas captained his Longshots to their second consecutive Open Division title with a 5-0 round robin record. Kinas was joined on the team by Jennifer McGaffigan, Raleigh, N.C.; Linda Tran, Flint, Mich.; and Catrina Thompson, Erica Fisk, Gordon Hammond, Alex Sugai, Mark Swanson, Derek Brooks, and Devin Luzod, all of Las Vegas, Nev.

For most of the teams, the weekend event was a qualifying event to earn their way to the National Finals in November. Recreational tennis teams from California, New Mexico, Nevada, Texas and Puerto Rico won regional titles and will advance to the WTT National Finals, Oct. 31-Nov. 2, in Indian Wells, Calif., where they will battle champions from five other qualifying events.

The Las Vegas qualifier is the second of six WTT Rec League qualifying events. The next WTT National Qualifier will be July 18-20 in Kansas City, Mo. Other qualifiers will be held this year in Raleigh, N.C.; Wilmington, Del.; and Irvine, Calif.

**3.0 DIVISION:** Puerto Rico captured the 3.0 Division title as Team Gonzalez, led by Agustin Gonzalez of Bayamon, P.R., outdistanced their division with a 3-0 record. The West Texas Smashers of Lubbock, Texas, finished second with a 2-1 record. Team Gonzalez dominated the Smashers in their only head-to-head meeting, 34-15. Although a team from Puerto Rico won the national 3.0 title in 2007, this will be the first trip to the National Finals for Team Gonzalez.

**3.5 DIVISION:** Another team making their first trip to the WTT National Finals is the Red Hot Lobos of Albuquerque, N.M. The Lobos, led by captain Larry Rafter, were undefeated in the 3.5 Division with a 3-0 record to advance to the semifinals where they defeated Passing Shots 25-21. In the finals, the Lobos downed the top-seeded Tulsa Guys & Dolls of Tulsa, Okla., 32-27, for the title.

**4.0 DIVISION:** The finals of the 4.0 Division were a battle of two undefeated teams, the Lubbock Line Steppers of Lubbock, Texas, and the Knights That Say NEE of Houston, Texas. Lubbock had too much firepower for their Texas rivals, outgunning the Knights 30-19 in the championship match. Brad Andrews and Lisa Alderson, both of Lubbock, Texas, co-captained the Line Steppers.

**4.5 DIVISION:** Carmel Valley Tennis, led by Becky Kuba of Rancho Santa Fe, Calif., earned their first trip to the National Finals with a 33-25 victory over the Four Fives of Albuquerque, N.M. Both teams were undefeated in round robin match play to advance to the championship match.

**SENIOR 3.5:** The Vegas Oldies I of Las Vegas, Nev., are returning to the National Finals after winning the Senior 3.5 Division with a 5-0 record. Led by captain Don Curnutt, the Oldies outscored their opponents 155-102 in their five matches.

**SENIOR 4.0:** The Primetime Kruzers of Clovis, Calif., upset top seed Baypoint of San Diego, Calif., 30-25, to win the Senior 4.0 Division title. Although Baypoint advanced to the Finals with a 4-0 record, they couldn't pull off the fifth win for the title. Carole Heinrichs captained the Kruzers, who broke a 3-way tie in their flight to advance to the finals based on winning percentage.
