



## NOVO NORDISK DONNELLY AWARDS CRITERIA



Presented annually through WTT Charities, Inc. Recipients must be between the ages of 12 and 21, have diabetes, and must play tennis competitively in tournaments, high school, or college.

**WHAT:** Two one-time awards of \$5,000 each given annually to two young people aged 12-21 who have diabetes and play tennis competitively in tournaments or on their school team. The awards are to be used for education, tennis development, and/or medical care. Winners to be presented their awards by Billie Jean King at a World TeamTennis match, date and site to be determined, in July 2010. In addition, there will be two one-time regional finalist awards in the amount of \$2,500 each. One will be awarded to an individual meeting the same criteria above who lives in the east region and the other in the west region. These awards will not be presented in person.

Diane was an all-American and NCAA doubles champion at Northwestern University and Tracey achieved all-Big Ten honors at the University of Iowa.

Diabetes is no match for these dynamic women. With the same spirit that characterized the legendary career of Billie Jean King, Diane and Tracey lead full, healthy, and active lives. Their diabetes has taught them to be disciplined and to stay in top physical shape.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** You must: 1) be between the ages 12 to 21 (male or female); 2) in good academic standing at school; 3) be able to provide doctor's confirmation of diabetes diagnosis; 4) currently be a competitive tennis player either in high school or college, or in tournaments; 5) show strong personal character, values, sportsmanship and community involvement; and 6) demonstrate financial need as indicated on the application.

**HOW TO APPLY:** Applications must be received by April 15, 2010, along with two recommendation letters and a short essay regarding the significance of diabetes in your life. Finalists will need to submit a doctor's statement verifying they have diabetes and might be asked to submit parents' tax returns from 2008 and 2009.
